"Moving Ag Forward" Vocational Ag Career Training Scholarship Application
Application Deadline: October 31, 2023

The Cook County Farm Bureau Foundation is offering vocational agriculture career training scholarships up to \$1,250 per scholarship (while funds are available) to students enrolled in a vocational training program or at an Illinois Community College for CDL truck driver training, diesel mechanics, welding, or technology with a focus on an agriculturally connected career. **For individuals seeking an associate degree with the intent to pursue an agriculturally related career, please complete a general scholarship application available on our website*.*

Enrollment deadline for this round of "Moving Ag Forward" is October 31, 2023. This is for individuals enrolled in a program between January 1 and April 30, 2024.

Other enrollment periods, while funds last, will be open the following dates:

- February 28, 2024 deadline for program enrollment May 1 – August 31
- July 31, 2024 deadline for program enrollment September 1 – December 31

Section 1 Personal Information and Eligibility Guidelines

All applicants must meet these guidelines:

- Must be an Illinois resident.
- Must be enrolled in and provide proof of enrollment into a vocational training program at an Illinois Community College during the corresponding timeframe.
- Must provide an endorsement signed by a Cook County farmer, Cook County Farm Bureau leader, area agribusiness, or area food processing business.
- Cook County Farm Bureau Foundation directors and employees of Cook County Farm Bureau or their immediate family members are not eligible to apply.
- Must have a farm bureau membership or be a dependent of a member in good standing.
- An application will not be considered without a signed endorsement based on endorsement guidelines.

Awards will be made based on evaluation of application by the Cook County Farm Bureau Foundation board of directors.

If all funds allocated to the program are distributed, the next cycle of scholarships will be postponed until the next fiscal year of the Foundation.

Applicants receiving the scholarship must provide proof of enrollment. If an applicant does not provide proof of enrollment, they forfeit the scholarship. Scholarship payments will be made directly to the vocational program or Community College where the recipient is enrolled for the training program.
