The Cook County Farm Bureau Foundation is offering grants to supplement your classroom's curriculum. Grant open to educators in **Grades 6-12** including public, private or homeschool classrooms located in Cook County, IL. Maximum grant amount is \$350.

#### **Grant Selection Criteria**

Ag Literacy Committee members will review all funding requests that are properly completed online by **11:59 p.m. Feb. 28, 2023**. When selecting grants to fund, the committee will take into consideration the following:

- Quality and uniqueness of the lesson, activity or project and its relationship to agriculture
- How well the lesson integrates agriculture into a variety of curriculum areas
- Alignment to Common Core Learning Standards
- · Assessment method required in order to evaluate learning or success of project
- Completed applications should not exceed two pages
