

The Cook County Farm Bureau® Foundation organization, established in 1997, is a 501c(3) nonfor profit with a purpose of accepting tax-deductible donations based on IRS guidelines to be used to carry out charitable, literary, leadership training and educational work in agriculture in the Cook County area. The Foundation key programs include "farm, food & agriculture" related scholarships for members/dependents pursuing higher education, internships, sponsorships of various agricultural literacy programming activities in the County for youth, and adult agricultural leadership and education scholarships.
