

Seed to Sale

- CBD Oil Sales
- CBD Infused Product Sales

- Oil is extracted using Co2, Butane or Ethanol
- Types: Full Spectrum vs. Isolate/Crystalline
- Hemp CBD Oil/Isolate is currently selling for \$7,000 -\$25,000 per L/KG, depending on quantity ordered and quality of the product
- All batches must be tested and labeled with a Certificate of Analysis (COA)
- Product packaging and labeling standards are better.
- Hemp also produces CBG, CBC and Terpenes

CBD OIL MARKETS

- According to Brightfield Group, the hemp-derived CBD market is expected to increase from \$591 million in 2018 to \$22 billion by 2022. That is nearly 40X growth in four years.
- Currently, 29% of the hemp-CBD market's sales come through natural food stores, 24% are online and 23% are derived from smoke shops. By 2022, Brightfield predicts that 64% of sales will be through retail chains like Walgreens, CVS Health and more.
- Wholesale Oil is sold to edible manufacturers, infused topicals manufacturers and brokers/distributors of CBD oil contracts

HEMP SEED MARKET

- Market prices of Hemp seed are increasing at a rate of approximately \$500 per week.
- Most quality Hemp seed distributors are sold out or will sell out of the high CBD producing strains.
- High CBD strains are traditionally considered to be seeds producing 14-19% CBD.
- This variation in CBD potency has much to do with the environment, soil, etc.
