Maximum grant amount \$500.

Grant Selection Criteria

Ag Literacy Committee members will review all funding requests that are properly completed and postmarked by **February 16, 2021.**

- Quality and uniqueness of the lesson, activity or project and its relationship to agriculture
- Projects should focus on integrating agriculture into a variety of curriculum areas.
- Must be aligned to Learning Standards
- · Assessment method required in order to evaluate learning or success of project
- Completed applications should not exceed two pages.
