Discussion on food insecurity services and issues

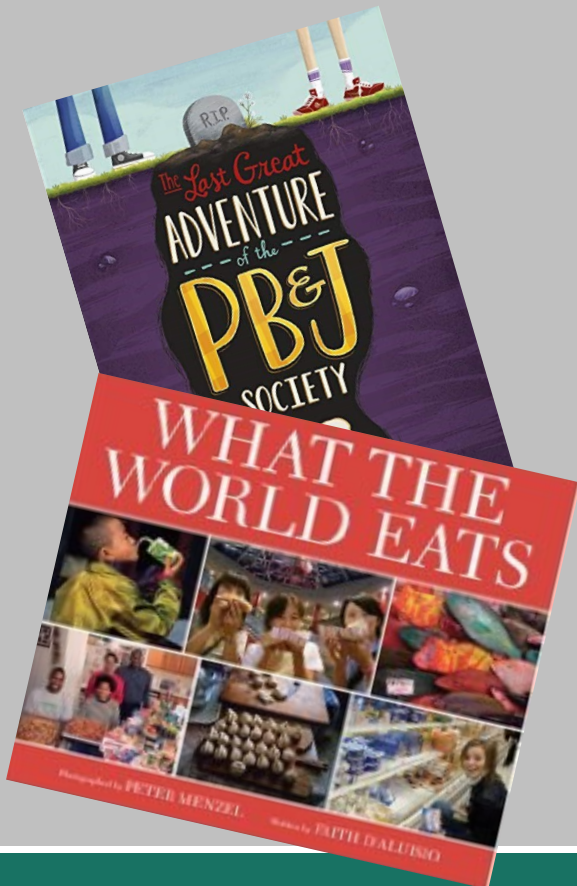
Presentation by a local farmer
